

# AOC Educational Foundation Identified To Receive Combined Federal Campaign Contributions

The BMC of the AOC Educational Foundation Inc. was recently notified that it would again be part of the 2002 Combined Federal Campaign. This will be the second year that the AOC Educational Foundation will participate in the Combined Federal Campaign. The Foundation is a non-profit, tax-exempt organization, providing scholarship assistance for college undergraduates and military enlisted personnel pursuing an education that may lead to careers in electronic defense/information operations or related fields. As a 501(c)(3) charitable organization, donations to the foundation are tax deductible for individuals and organizations as allowed by federal and state tax laws.

The Combined Federal Campaign of San Antonio and Bexar County is the largest, private health and human service organization in Bexar County.
